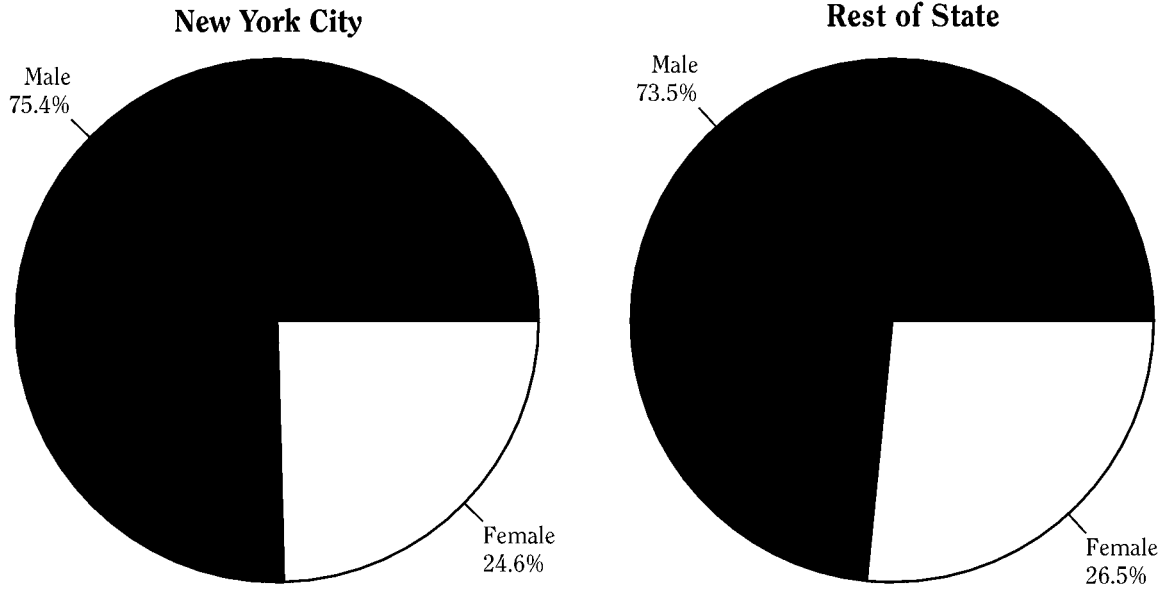

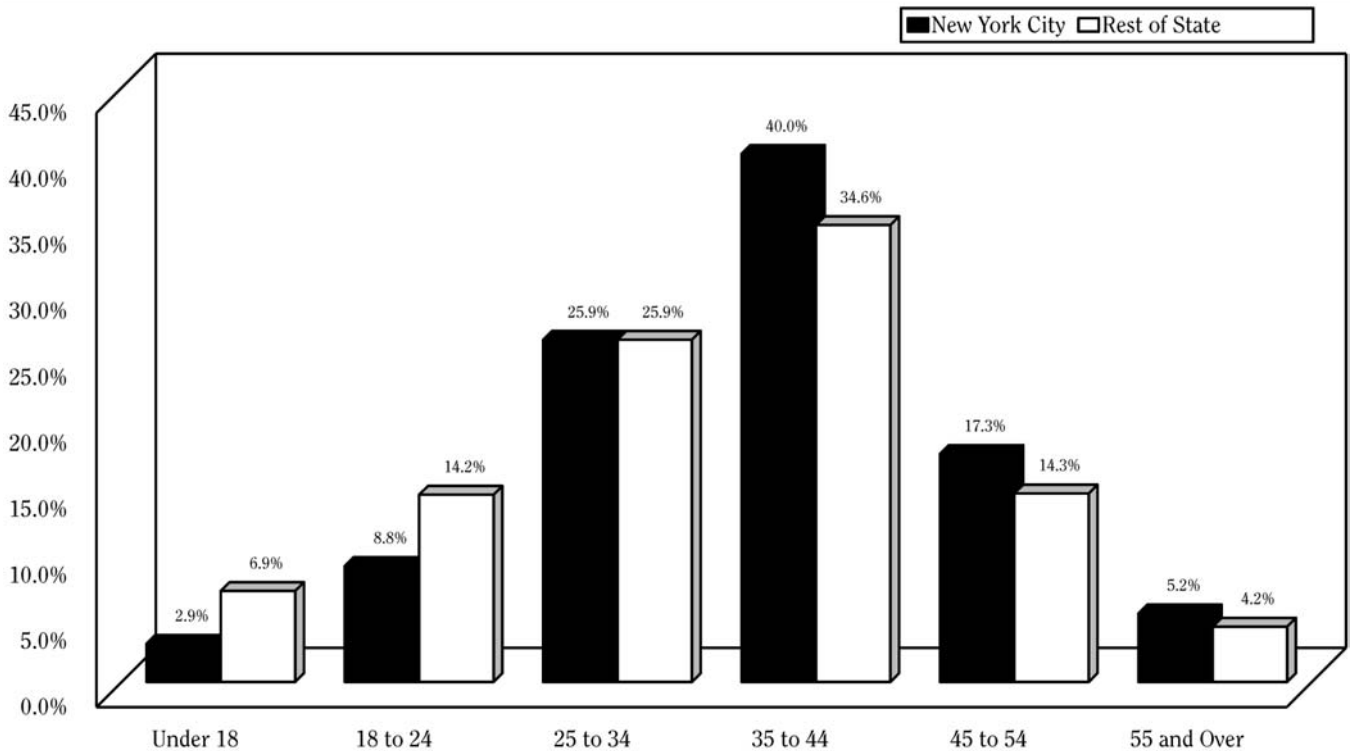
**Admission to Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Treatment

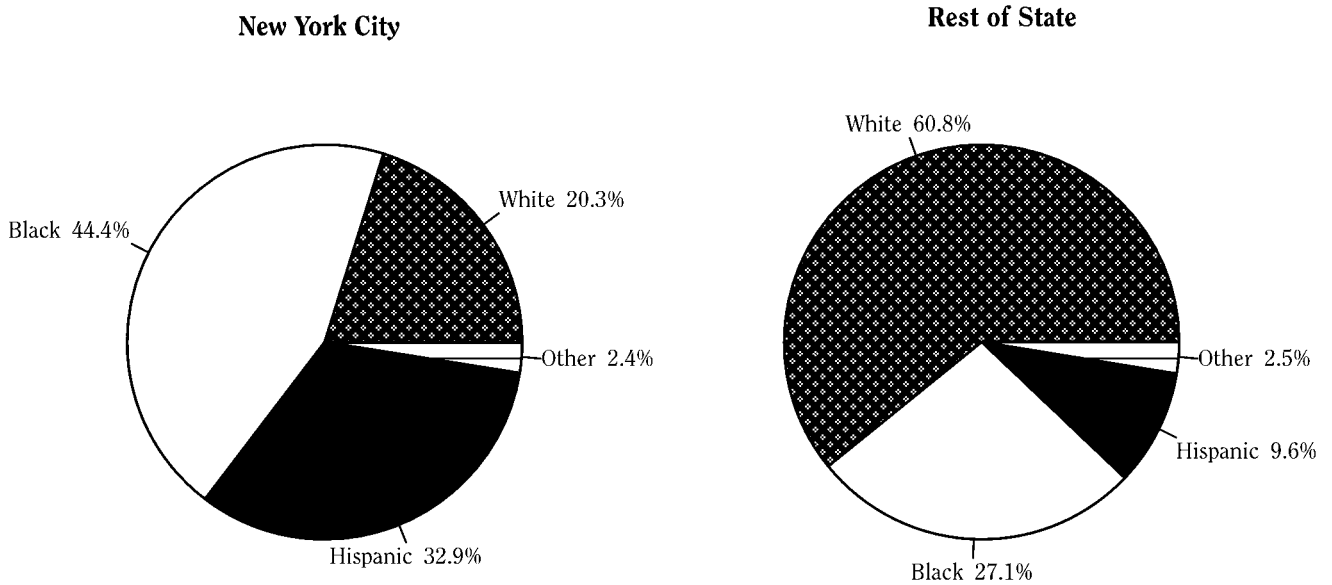

New York State by Age Group — 2000**



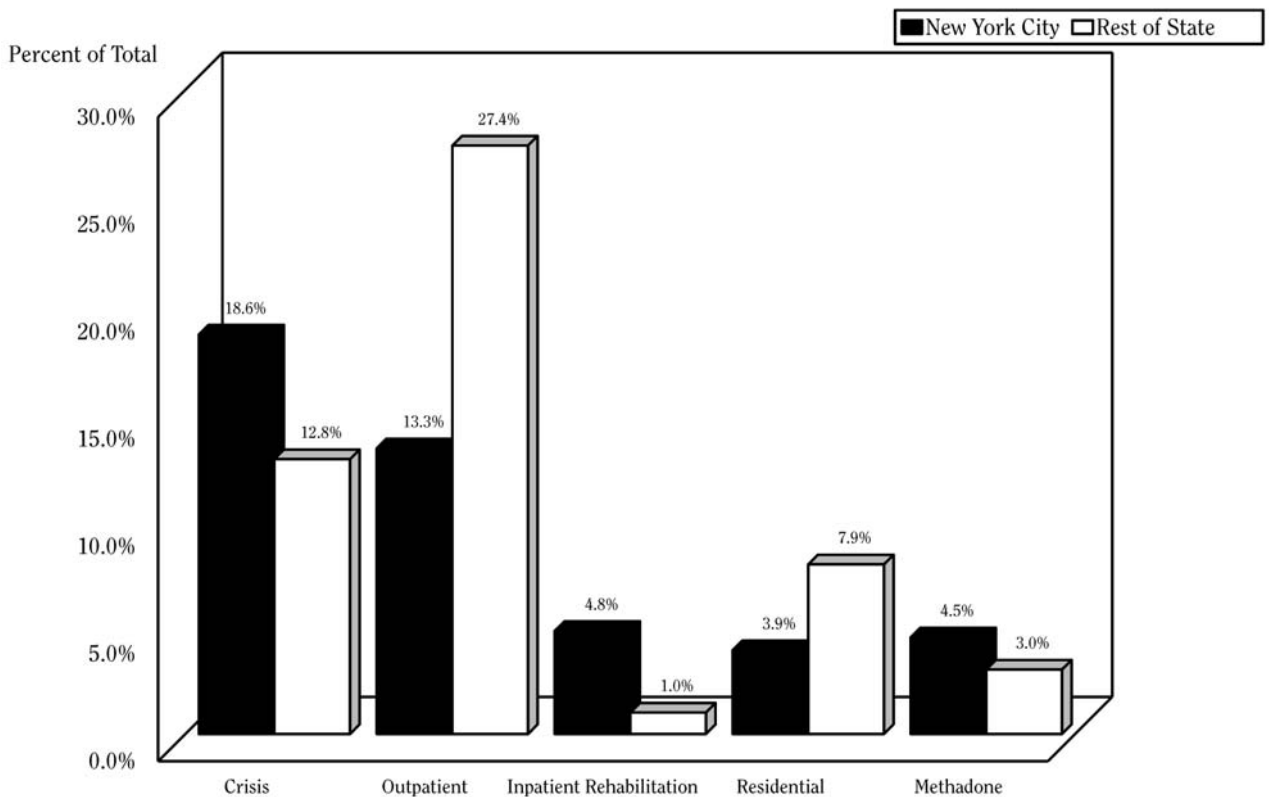
