



Section H

Public Safety and the Criminal Justice System

Information on public safety in New York State — including police; crime rates; courts; prisons; children and family services; discrimination; and fire fighting.

Highlights

- There were approximately 55,000 full-time uniformed police in New York State in 2004. Sixty-five percent were employed by the New York City Police Department.
- The crime rate in New York State was 2,588.0 per 100,000 population in 2004. This includes murder, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny, and motor vehicle theft.
- There were approximately 4.1 million filings in New York State trial courts in 2004.
- There were over 63,000 inmates in state correctional facilities in November 2005. Over 95 percent of the inmates were men.
- Over 86 percent of all discrimination complaints filed in New York State in fiscal year 2005-06 were employment related.
- There were 1.2 million fire department calls in New York State in 2004, including fires, rescue/EMS, and false alarms; about 90,000 of these calls were for fires.
