Information on health and related topics in New York State — including hospitals; psychiatric centers; substance abuse treatment; Social Security; Medicaid; temporary and family assistance; Food Stamps; and foster care.

Highlights

- Over 2.6 million patients were discharged from hospitals in New York State in 2006
- Approximately 7,000 New Yorkers were admitted to state psychiatric centers in fiscal year 2006-07.
- Over 300,000 people were admitted to substance abuse treatment in New York in 2006. Approximately 33 percent were 35 to 44 years of age.
- Over 640,000 New Yorkers received close to \$3.9 billion in Supplemental Security Income in 2006.
- The average monthly number of Medicaid beneficiaries in New York increased by approximately 61,000 from 2004 to 2005. Sixty-eight percent of the recipients lived in New York City.
- Approximately 1.8 million New Yorkers received almost \$2.3 billion in Food Stamp benefits in 2006.
- There were 27,191 children in foster care in New York State on December 31, 2006, an increase of 1 per cent when compared to December 31, 2005.

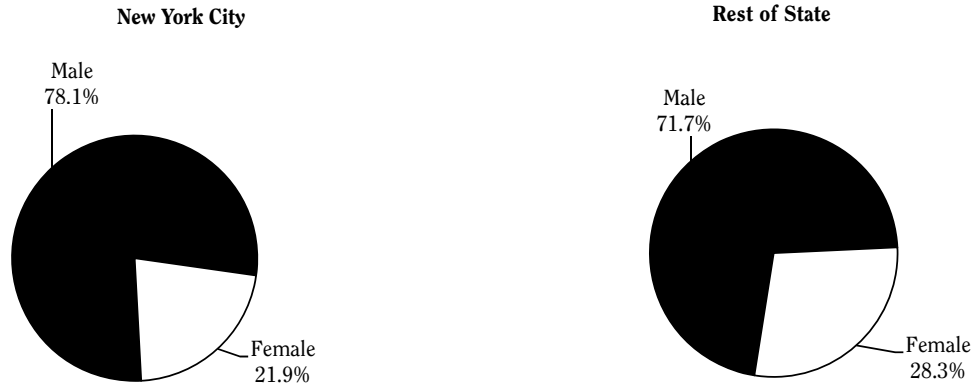

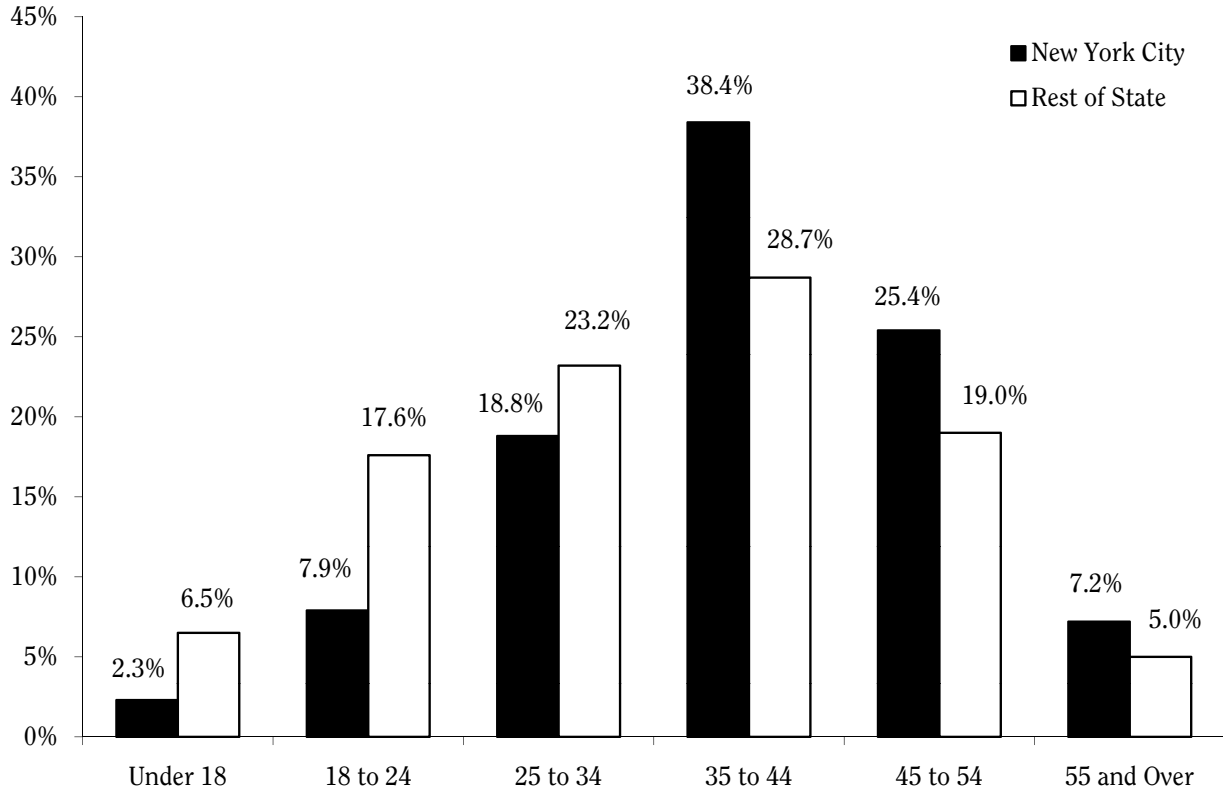

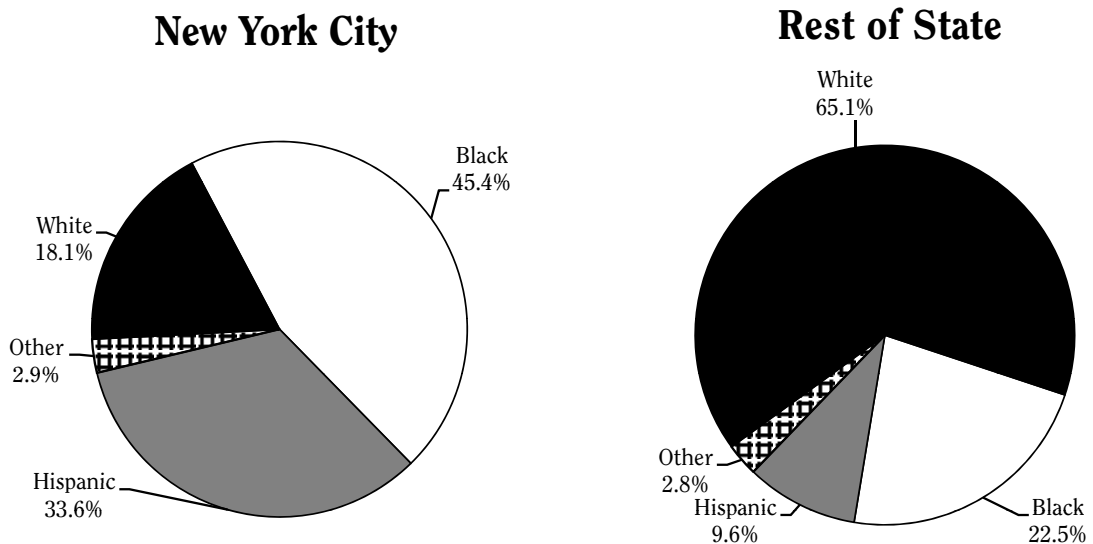

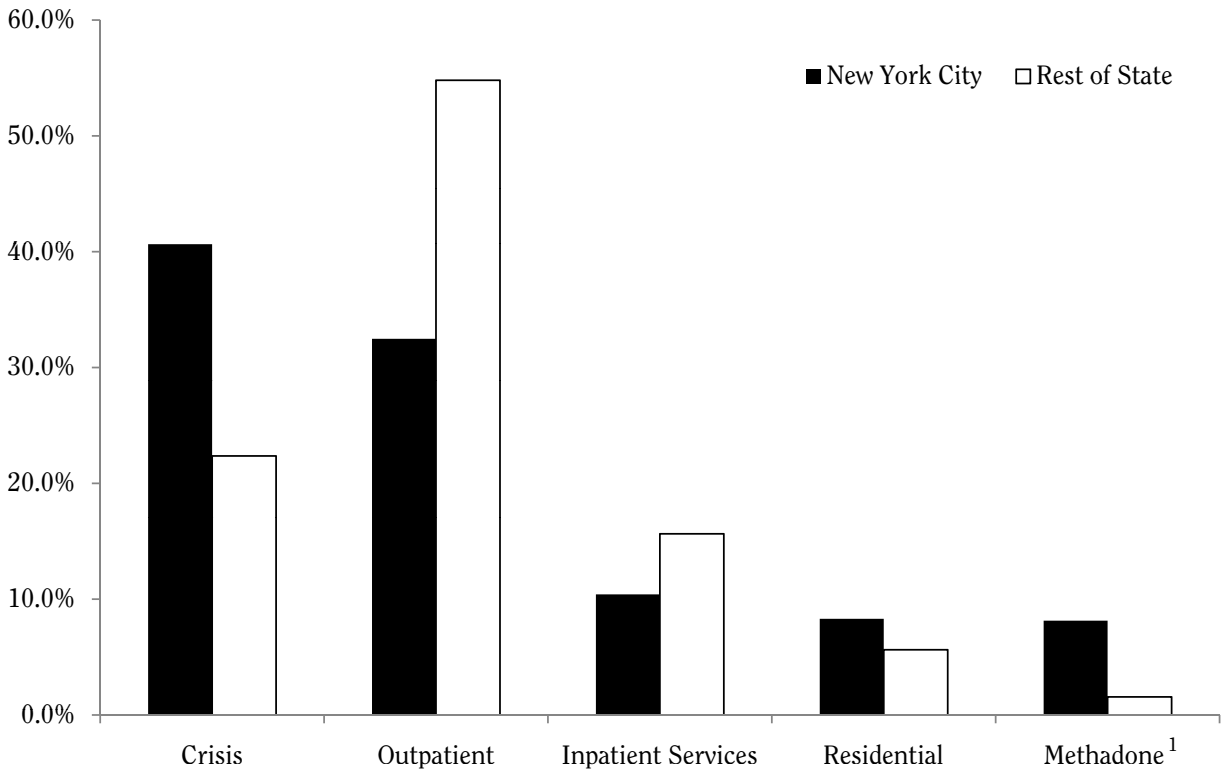
