MSA Metropolitan Statistical Area. Must contain:

- (a) A total MSA population of 100,000 or more, and
- (b) At least one city with 50,000 or more inhabitants, or
- (c) A Census Bureau-defined "urbanized area" of at least 50,000 inhabitants.

PMSA Primary Metropolitan Statistical Area:

- (a) Must contain a large urbanized county (or cluster of counties that demonstrate very strong economic and social links); and
- (b) Must have close ties to other portions of the larger area (i.e., the CMSA).

All PMSAs are components of a CMSA.

CMSA Consolidated Metropolitan Statistical Area. Must contain:

- (a) More than 1.0 million population; and
- (b) Two or more PMSAs.

Micro: Micropolitan Statistical Area — A county or group of counties around at least one Census Bureau-defined urban Cluster with between 10,000 and 49,999 inhabitants and without an urbanized area of 50,000 or more inhabitants.

Comb: Combined Statistical Area — A group of Metropolitan and/or Micropolitan Statistical Areas that share a moderate connection with each other.

Metro: Metropolitan Statistical Area — A county or socio-economically integrated group of counties around at least one Census Bureau-defined urbanized area with at least 50,000 inhabitants.

Div: Metropolitan Division — A county or group of counties tied to a single employment center within a Metropolitan Statistical Area with a single urbanized area of at least 2.5 million inhabitants.
